

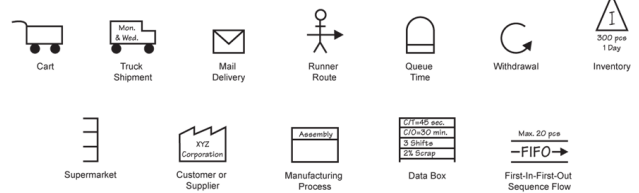
LEAN TOOLS : VISUAL CONTROLS
